Basil S. Savopoulos, age 86, of Bear, DE, went home to the Lord on May 15, 2021. He was born in Chester, PA to the late Sotirios and Eleftheria Savopoulos. Basil was a kind, generous, and loving man who was devoted to his family. As a dedicated Christian, he was committed to living his life for the glory of God.
