



Paul Gilbert Truax

September 16, 1943 - April 4, 2021

Paul Gilbert Truax, age 77, went home to be with his Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ, on Easter Sunday, April 4, 2021 after a brief bout with cancer.

Paul was born September 16, 1943 to Ralph and Odelia Truax in Wilmington, DE. He graduated from P.S. DuPont High School in 1961 and the University of Delaware in 1965 before launching a successful career in IT and sales consulting. He had an entrepreneurial spirit and owned several businesses through the years. Paul led a Christ-centered life and played an active role in his church and his men's small group, Promise Keepers. He was a servant at heart, looking for tangible ways to improve the lives of people around him.

Surviving him are his loving wife, Beth Onderdonk Truax; his sister, Janet Orme; his children: Kathryn T.
