



A.M. (Doc) Mamunul Islam MD

January 1, 1934 - October 4, 2013

A.M. (Doc) Mamunul Islam MD, age 79, of New Castle, DE passed away on Friday October 4, 2013 following a battle with prostate cancer. After graduating from Dhaka Medical School in Bangladesh, Dr. Islam embarked on his American dream in 1960 when he arrived in the United States with only one suitcase to pursue medical training at Middlesex General Hospital in New Brunswick, NJ. Dr. Islam dedicated his life to education, career, and, most of all, his family. A general practitioner at Delaware State Hospital for over 30 years before retiring, Dr Islam also worked part-time for many years at the Veterans Administration Medical Center in Elsmere to provide for his family in the USA as well as his mother and siblings back in Bangladesh. Protective of his patients, Dr. Islam would go the extra mile to make sure they received proper care. He loved gardening, cooking, discussing current events, watching tennis matches, news, Bollywood films, & The Amazing Race on television, and taking photos of his family, colleagues & neighbors through the years.

Dr. Islam is survived by his loving and faithful wife of 51 years, Marjorie Islam; 2 sons, Dr. David Islam and his wife Dr. Janine Islam, and Mark Islam; 3 grandchildren, Susan, Jeffrey and Maria; 2 brothers, Serajul and Sujaul Islam; sisters, Shunu Miah, Ranu Mannan, and Kochi Begum. He is preceded in death by his father Anwaruddin Ahmed and mother Nurjahan Begum; a

brother, Nurul Islam, and a sister, Minu Moinuddin.
