



## Anthony "Tony" J. Reimer

October 25, 1919 - July 20, 2015

Anthony "Tony" J. Reimer, age 95, of Bear, DE, went home to be with the Lord on July 20, 2015. He passed away peacefully at his home of more than 67 years. He was the son of the late Antonio S. and Louise (Feret) Reimer. Tony retired in 1990 after working for Delaware Concrete Products, Inc. for over 51 years rising to the position of Superintendent and Vice President. Indicative of his dry sense of humor, he liked to say he took a few years off from work to serve in the Army as a warehouse foreman, general clerk, and shop clerk during World War II. After retirement, he continued working in his garden, restored a 1958 Cadillac, and took up wood-working, creating small crafts as well as working on larger projects. He remained active till declining health affected his mobility in March, 2014.

He is survived by his loving wife, Louella G. (Shepherd) Reimer of 67 years, his son Anthony W. Reimer and wife Virginia of Pylesville, MD, his daughter Linda L. Flohr and husband Terry of Bear, DE, and his son Steven D. Reimer and wife Xilpha of Chester, VA; 5 grandchildren, Robert Reimer and wife Melissa, Laura Flohr, Kelly Reimer, Daniel Flohr, and Stephanie Reimer; 6 great-grandchildren Samantha Reimer, Richard Reimer, Louella Reimer, Amanda Reimer, John Reimer, and Nathanael Reimer.

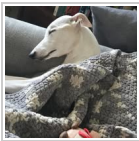
