Antoinette (Toni) J. Detrich, 96, died Tuesday, January 7, 2020, at the Christiana Hospital in Newark, DE. She was born March 29, 1923, in Hollsopple, PA, to Anthony and Victoria Lebda. Toni was the last to survive of 10 siblings.

She is survived by her 5 children: Robert Detrich, Thomas Detrich, Sandra Bacci, Janet Taylor, and Barbara L'Italien; as well as 16 grandchildren and 20 great-grandchildren; a legacy of so many who will love her forever.

Living to the age of 96, she had an amazing story: including being added to an American Rosie the Riveter Association Memorial for her part in serving during World War II. She earned her degree that advanced her career to serve as a government secretary. Raising 5 children as a single parent most of her life, she was a long-time resident of Pasadena, MD where she enjoyed investing time in her home, gardening, watching her favorite baseball team, the Orioles, hosting family get-togethers and helping her family, which she cherished in countless ways.

She hoped the fruit of her life as a mother would echo the words from the Bible verse, Proverbs 31:28, "Her children would rise and call her blessed". As her life here on earth was ending, and her journey to heaven was beginning, she passed peacefully while family gathered around. Singing her favorite

hymn, Amazing Grace, many tears in our goodbye were shed, and many joyful memories were shared that did echo our gratitude and love to this amazing woman, mother, grandmother, and great grandmother. Truly we do call you blessed and we will love you forever.
