Carl A. Czajczynski, 87, of Bear, DE, passed away on September 22, 2022. Born in Jackson, Michigan, Carl was a graduate of Chatsworth High School in Illinois, where he lettered in both track and basketball. After graduation, he joined the U.S. Airforce and was honorably discharged after four years of service. He worked at Bell Telephone (AT&T) for 33 years and retired in 1989. In 1992, he sold his home in Aston, PA and traveled in his motor home before settling in Bear, DE, where he became a member of St. Elizabeth Ann Seton Roman Catholic Church. Carl enjoyed gambling, archery, bowling, wine making, RC airplanes, boating and making his famous bell telephone stools. He loved to tell stories and jokes. He will be missed by all who knew him.
