



## Clark W. DeMott III

August 18, 1933 - May 8, 2021

Clark W. DeMott III passed away Saturday, May 8, 2021. He was born in 1933. Clark was a graduate of Brown Vocational High School and after graduation served in the US Navy (Seabees). As a lifetime member of the Carpenters Local Union #626, Clark began a 49-year career with John E. Healy & Sons Construction Company starting as a carpenter and then as a construction superintendent on numberless construction projects before retiring as president of the company. Clark and his family enjoyed time at their beach house in Ocean City, MD, which was built by Clark. He was very active in exercising, running, cycling, and playing volleyball.
