Donna M. MacLeod Loughran, age 80, of Wilmington, DE, died in the company of her loving family on Tuesday, December 16, 2014.

Born in Buffalo, NY, she was the daughter of the late Donald and Laretta MacLeod. Donna was proud of her Scottish heritage and was a descendant of the 1851 exiles from the Isle of Lewes, Scotland. Donna graduated from Niagara University with a Masters degree and was a Registered Nurse for 60 years. She was Associate Chief of Nursing for the Wilmington Delaware Veterans Administration Medical Center. Donna loved nature and was a talented painter.
