Nell was born in Ronceverte, West Virginia on October 30, 1920, and shortly after her birth, moved to Hinton, WV where she lived until she and her four sisters moved to Elkton, Maryland to work at Triumph Explosives during World War II. Following the war, Nell worked for Acme Markets in Elkton for 20 years until she decided to be a full time homemaker. Nell was loved by all that she interacted with and thrived on time spent with family and was always ready to share a story about growing up in West Virginia or about her life during World War II. She was kind, caring, and did all she could to help others in a very unconditional way. She was a wonderful cook and spent hours in the kitchen making her famous apple cakes, fudge and dumplings. Nell was a member of the Elkton United Methodist Church, where in her earlier years, she served as a Sunday School Teacher and a member of the Women's Circle. She loved reading her Bible and her daily devotions. Nell also spent many hours watching old movies and her favorite show, Family Feud. She was a devoted wife, mother, grandmother, aunt, and friend.

She is survived by her daughter, Margaret Prljaca and George R. Burns; grandsons, Michael Prljaca of Sydney Australia, Matthew Prljaca and wife Desiree Miller-Prljaca and great grandson Kaiden Alexander Prljaca; and brother-in-law, Howard O. Husfelt. Nell is also survived by many loving nieces and nephews.

She was preceded in death by her husband, William Cyrus Husfelt; her parents, Mary and Clarence Evans; brothers: Charles Samuel, Clarence (Junior), Bob, Eddie; and sisters: Mabel Reynolds, Hazel Wiseman, Mary McLaughlin, and Helen McKnight and her son-in-law Paul Prljaca.
