When there were get-togethers at his home, the night generally ended one of

two ways, talking around the table, or pulling out the guitar.

When it came to food, Ed especially enjoyed experimenting with his smoker. He produced many a fine meal with that smoker. Ed discovered craft beer before it became cool, and enjoyed finding a unique beer and talking about it. He eventually turned that love of craft beer into a blog that he wrote for several years, earning him the title of "Celebrity Beer Blogger Ed" among friends. His camera was always at the ready. He enjoyed taking pictures of nature and when he was blogging, at beer events. Then there were the movies...Ed loved the superhero movies from the comics of his childhood. He could talk for hours about the characters, the cinematography, the storyline, and the departure from the original storyline. That was often the topic when everyone gathered around the table. Second to Halloween, he loved St. Patrick's Day. That was a day of Irish music, lamb stew, Guinness, and a viewing of "The Quiet Man".

Ed was a man who brought a lot of life and laughter to those who knew him. There was not a dull moment when he existed in a room. He was loved and will be missed by so many. He often shared the quote by Dr. Who, "We're all stories in the end. Just make it a good one, eh?"
