February 25, 1934 - April 30, 2018

Harvey C. Kimmey Jr., age 84, passed away peacefully on April 30, 2018. Harvey was born on February 25, 1934 in Milford, DE to the late Harvey C. Kimmey Sr. and Mary Bunting Kimmey. A graduate of Milford High School, he moved to northern Delaware where he worked as a construction estimator. At the height of his career, he contributed to projects pivotal to the growth of the region, including the Delaware Memorial Bridge and the Christiana Hospital in Newark, DE.

Alongside his family, Harvey attended Faith Baptist Church, Grace Evangelical Church, and later Pike Creek Bible Church. He enjoyed especially singing hymns. Harvey aspired to be a leader of his community. He was a proud member of the Penndrew Manor Civic Association and the Conservative Caucus of Delaware, where he found others who shared his interest in history and politics.

In 2011, Harvey moved to the Edgehill Nursing and Rehabilitation Center to be close to his daughter Mary J. Blake, her husband Rob, and their son Thomas. His sole grandchild, Thomas brought boundless joy to his Pop-pop. Harvey found exceptional care and a home at Edgehill and is remembered for his sense of humor and his champion chess and checker skills. The family extends gratitude to the care providers and condolences to friends he made among the residents and staff. He will be missed. Especially by his beloved
