



## Horace L. "Pop" Coffin

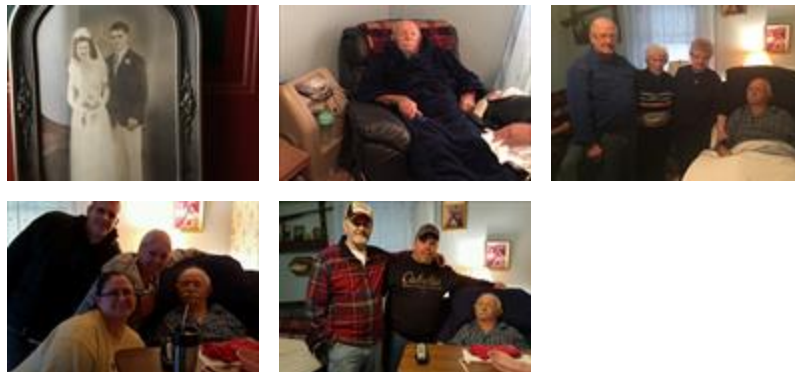

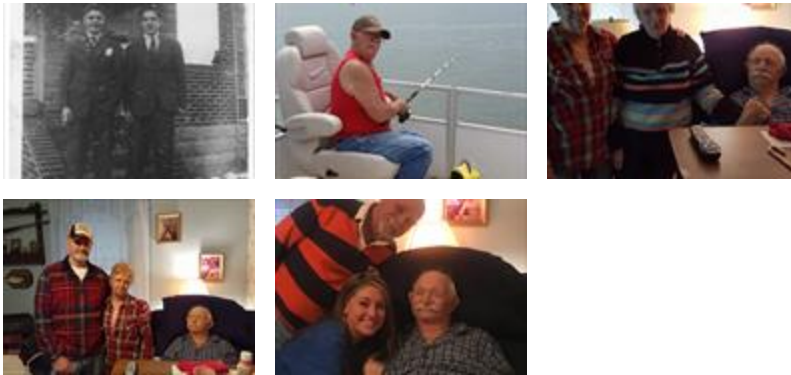
