He was a true gentleman at an early age. He was always helping the elderly

ones in the neighborhood with their groceries and assisted them if they needed a ride home from the Food Market and the Bank called PSFS.

Joel and Anita met in the year 1994 while she was visiting her friends in Roxborough. And he layed his eyes on Anita, and the rest is "HISTORY." In the year 1996, that's when Anita Louise Clark's name changed to Anita Louise Brown. They both were the love of each other's life. Outside of their children. After their children were grown, they both loved to travel, and they both complemented each other with their dress and their personalities.

But the best year of his life is when he dedicated himself to Jehovah God and symbolized it by water baptism Saturday, July 20, 2019, at the Liacouras Center on Broad Street in Philadelphia, PA. 19130
