December 20, 1925 - November 28, 2008

Joseph P. Marcone, age 82, of Newark, DE, passed away on Friday, November 28, 2008 at his daughter's home, after a courageous three year cancer battle. His children were at his side. Joseph worked for over 25 years as a US Postal Letter Carrier out of the Marshallton Branch. He was a member of the Postal Union Branch 191, was a shop steward for the Marshallton Branch, and served as a delegate for both State and National Postal Unions. Joseph was a lifelong member of Our Lady of Fatima Roman Catholic Church. He served our country in the 22nd Regiment – 6th Marine Division of the US Marine Corp during WWII. He saw combat in the Pacific Theatre at the Battles for Eniwetok, Guam and Okinawa. He was fiercely proud of his service in the Corps. In addition, Joseph was a traveler, artist, collector, animal lover, bicyclist, and avid reader.

Mr. Marcone is survived by 1 son, John E. Marcone; 2 daughters, N. Lisa Pilchard & husband Russell and Joanne M. Collins & husband Paul; 1 brother, Carmen Marcone; and 6 grandchildren: Russell, Elizabeth, John, Julia, Faith, and Lydia. In addition, there are many nieces and nephews. He was preceded in death by his wife Doris Bookhammer Marcone in 1986 and by 3 brothers: Dominic Martine, Anthony Martine, and Peter Marcone, and 2 sisters, Julie Tolmie and Margaret Scandone .
