



## Kermit Eugene Stacy

August 20, 1942 - June 29, 2015

Kermit Eugene Stacy, age 72, of Wilm., DE, passed away peacefully surrounded by his loving family on Monday, June 29, 2015. Kermit was known as the "Honorary Mayor of Glasgow Trailer Park". He formerly owned and operated H & S Getty in Delaware City, worked at the Chrysler Assembly Plant, and Electric Hose & Rubber. Kermit served our Country in the US Navy aboard the USS Ranger in 1961 during the Viet Nam War.
