



Rev. Manuel L. Marrero

July 16, 1928 - May 4, 2016

Reverend Manuel Marrero, age 87, went home to be with the Lord on May 4, 2016 surrounded by his loved ones. In 1964 the Delaware community was blessed with Reverend Manuel Marrero. He was a pioneer sent here by our Lord Jesus Christ to open the very first Pentecostal church in Wilmington, Delaware. His impact as a pioneer for Christ has been felt not only in Delaware but as far as Nicaragua, where one of his early disciples has opened a new church.

Manny, as he was lovingly known, will be missed by his 6 children and their spouses: Maria Matos, Harry Marrero (Lydia), Manuel Marrero Jr., Olga Burns (William), Angel Marrero, and Debora Shackelford (Ronald); 18 grandchildren; 28 great grandchildren; and a host of cousins, nieces and nephews in Puerto Rico and New Jersey. He was predeceased by his wife of 64 years, Monserrate Marrero; daughter, Minerva Marrero Gonzalez; granddaughter, Ruth Maria Marrero Bollinger; brother, Jose Maria Marrero; and parents.
