Mary Rose Alexander, age 84, of New York, New York, passed away peacefully on February 27, 2009.

Mary was born in Wilmington, DE on February 2, 1925. She was a graduate of Wilmington High School in the class of 1943. Mary went on to study nursing and graduated from the Delaware School of Nursing in 1946. She was also a member of the US Cadet Nurse Core. Her service as a nurse took her to Los Angeles, CA in the fall of 1948 to help assist in the worst polio epidemic in US history. She became registered to practice nursing in New York City on December 7, 1952. Mary loved flowers and was presented a certificate of merit, from the mayor of Wilmington for turning a vacant city lot into a beautiful garden.

Mary is preceded in death by her parents Tito and Rose Giacchi. She is survived by her husband of 46 years, Robert H. Alexander of New York. Survivors also include four sisters, Alice Labazzo, Betty Syvy, Esther Micucio and Martha Grabowski and a brother, Joseph Labazzo.
