



Rev. Wesley Dean Davis

June 29, 1941 - March 1, 2018

Rev. Wesley Dean Davis, age 76, of Newark, DE, was called home to be with the Lord surrounded by his family Thursday, March 1, 2018 after a three year battle with Progressive Supra Nuclear Palsy. Dean was born and raised in Mullinville, KS. He graduated from Mullinville High School in 1959 and went on to Central Bible College to become a pastor for the Assemblies of God.

After marrying Shirley Reign in 1963 they moved to DE where Dean worked at Occidental Petroleum for 30 years. He retired in 2001 to pastor full time in Dove Creek, CO and then later in Colorado Springs, CO until moving back to DE in 2014.

Dean loved pastoring, farming, working on an elk ranch, fishing, traveling, picking dandelions, and spending time with family and friends.

Dean is survived by his wife of 54 years, Shirley R. Davis; daughters, DeAnn Lane and Joy Ide (Gregg) with whom he lived; 4 grandchildren: Beca Ide (Baird), Abigail Ide, Courtney Snyder (Seth), and Brandon Lane; 7 siblings: Vernon Davis (Nancy), Allen Davis, Patti Ann Baker, La Ruth Liechty (Gordon), Gerald Davis (Sue), Carol Lee Demant (Reinhart), and Dewain Davis (Jeannie); and many nieces and nephews. He was preceded in death by his parents, Ernest E. Davis and Verna Elnora Davis.

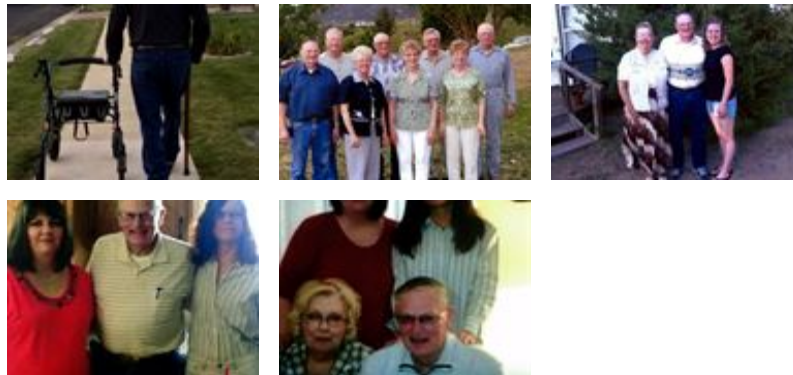
