Ruth Curtis Martin, age 90, of Newark, DE passed away peacefully surrounded by family on Friday, September 22, 2023. Born on September 17, 1933 in Proctorville, Ohio, Ruth was the daughter of the late Roy B. Curtis and Rosa (Adkins) Curtis. She married William I. Martin at the age of 18 on May 24, 1952 and moved to Detroit, Michigan, where they started their family together.
