Sandra Lee (Wilkinson) Williams, 64, of Newark, DE, went home to be with our Lord on Sunday, October 14, 2012.

As a military dependent, Sandra was a world traveler. She lived in Japan, Germany and several states in the U.S. She attended Valparaiso University and then completed a Bachelor's Degree in Mathematics at the University of Illinois. While Sandra chose to be a stay at home mom, she taught GED part-time for more than ten years. With her children grown, she earned a Bachelor's Degree in Accounting from the University of Delaware, but then chose to become a full time "Grandma" rather than pursuing a career. She loved watching and doing things with her granddaughters from knitting, to puzzles, to swimming, to soccer.

Through the years, she was active in her church, co-teaching Confirmation Class for many years, becoming a Certified Lay Speaker in the UMC, and serving as a Delegate to the Annual Conference of the UMC Peninsula Conference.

Sandra is survived by her husband of 44 years, Dennis Williams, a son, Patrick Williams (Barbara) of Middletown DE; daughter, Kristen DuHadaway, of Bear, DE; and 5 beloved granddaughters: Erin, Alli and Megan Williams, and Cora and Jennie DuHadaway. She is also survived by her father, Robert Wilkinson; brother, Daniel (Laurie) Wilkinson, both of Mazon, IL; and sisters, Roberta (Ken) Barnes of Dyer, IN and Tamara (Kevin) Halterman of Dwight, IL. She was predeceased by her mother, Marie Yvonne Burkhart Wilkinson.
