



Steven Cope

May 10, 1947 - May 20, 2015

On May 20, surrounded by his family, Steven Andrew Cope passed suddenly and unexpectedly. He was born in 1947 to Andy and Martha Cope in Long Island NY. They moved to Delaware in 1960 and he attended Dickinson High School. Following graduation from the U of Delaware he worked in the engineering department at DuPont. He developed a wide array of equipment and was awarded 8 patents and became a licensed professional engineer. His children were a strong focus. He was a volunteer soccer coach for over 20 years and was instrumental in starting the girl's high school soccer league in Delaware.

In 1998 he joined Accudyne Systems to continue his creative problem solving. Ultimately that work resulted in his cofounding Enliten LLC to provide fall protection and body weight support systems to people with disabilities. His work in that area resulted in his ninth and final patent which was allowed on the day he passed. In the last year, he divided his time between his work with the disabled and his family.

He is survived by his wife of 46 years, Christine; his children and their families, Brian and Anne Cope, Greg Cope, Jill and Kevin Souza; his grandchildren: Scott, Meg, Edge, Tristan, and Logan; his father, Andrew and step-mother Jeanne; his brothers Rick and Ralph and their families.

A visitation will be held Monday, June 1, 2015 from 2 – 3 pm in the Strano and Feeley Family Funeral Home, 635 Churchmans Road, Newark, DE 19702 followed by a celebration of Steve's life at 3 PM and then light fare overlooking
