Theron Joseph "Joey" Arrowood, age 35, born in Wilmington, DE, on April 24, 1984, passed away Thursday, October 3, 2019. Joey grew up in Port Penn, DE, and loved fishing and crabbing on the banks of the Delaware River. He and his family had recently moved back to Port Penn into his childhood home. Joey was very athletic and played baseball in the MOT league for many years. He was an all-star pitcher and was often referred to as "Smiling Joe" due to his relaxed and easy-going attitude on the mound during stressful situations.
