



## Dr. Thomas C. Scott Sr.

November 24, 1926 - June 19, 2024

Dr. Thomas C. Scott, DO, age 97, passed away peacefully on Wednesday June 19, 2024. Thomas was born to John and Catherine Scott on November 24, 1926. On August 15, 1953, he married the love of his life, Catherine Eleanor Dalrymple, to whom he was devotedly married for 70 years, and who preceded him in death on Feb 9, 2024. He was known for his faith in Jesus Christ, humble nature, love of his family, friends and patients and for his sense of humor. Dr. Scott served as a SSgt in the United States Army during World War II in the Pacific Theatre. He graduated from Hofstra University and earned his medical degree in 1954 from Philadelphia College of Osteopathic Medicine. Dr. Scott practiced medicine for over 33 years. During his career he was the family physician for Delaware City, directed Healthcare Delaware and Amerihealth out of St. Francis Hospital, and began the St. Clare Medical Van ministry there, bringing medical care to the poor and homeless of Wilmington, DE.

Thomas is survived by his son, Thomas C. Scott, Jr.; daughter, Catherine McQuaide (Chris); grandchildren, Shane (Janna) and Zachary Riggs and Abigail and Alexander Scott; great-grandchildren, Enoch and Ruth Riggs; brother Edmund (Roberta) Scott and many beloved nieces and nephews.
