Virginia "Ginny" T. Baker, age 80, of Newark, DE, passed away at home surrounded by loving family and friends Thursday, November 1, 2018. Ginny was born Virginia Eva Lee Thompson in Gettysburg, PA, to the late Mildred and Carl Thompson. She was raised on her parents' farm. Ginny met her husband, Marshall "Mike" Baker, while they were both working at the Naval Ordnance Lab near Washington, DC. They were married June 25, 1960 at St. John's Episcopal Church in Mount Rainier, MD and moved to DE. Ginny began working for the State Parks and became director in the 1970's. She gave birth to her only child, Rand Baker, on her husband's 48th birthday. Ginny postponed retirement for a couple of years then spent the rest of her life cherishing time with her family, spoiling her grandchildren, joining the Red Clay Garden Club, and enjoying her weekly Hand and Foot card games with her friends.
