William A. Logan, age 88, went home to be with the Lord on Friday, January 1, 2010. Mr. Logan proudly served in the U.S. Army, 138th Combat Engineer Brigade during WW II, where he saw action in the European Theater. He enjoyed hunting, trapping, fishing, and shared a commercial fishing boat, "Red Dog" with his brother, Porky. He was a member of Iron Workers Local Union 451 in Elsmere, DE before retiring in 1983. He was a life member of Holloway Terrace Fire Company for 72 years, and lifetime member of Bull Hill Boatyard Assn. and the New Castle Senior Wharf Group.
